

# **TBY ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES**

## **Revised 8/3/2021**

1. Those attending a service or meeting should have no fever or other symptoms. Per the Central Conference of American Rabbis (CCAR) guidelines, if you are unvaccinated or immunocompromised, we ask that you attend virtually.
2. Masks will be required for all attendees 2 years of age and older, regardless of vaccination status.
3. We will provide a separate seating section with social distancing for those who prefer that, and for those who are immunocompromised.
4. For those not comfortable or unable to attend in person, services will be available virtually.
5. Specifically for High Holidays, we will limit in person attendance to members and their families. We will offer non-members the option to attend virtually. This is to allow enough room for our socially distanced section.
6. Singing is permitted as long as the above conditions are maintained.
7. We will not have any food in the building until further notice.
8. At each service/meeting each attendee will check in, in order to have a list of attendees for contact tracing capability. Anyone who has attended a TBY service/meeting shall notify the Temple if later tested positive for the virus. If this occurs, others who attended the service/meeting shall be notified.
