

# **TBY ATTENDANCE GUIDELINES**

## **Revised 10/5/2021**

1. Those attending a service or meeting should have no fever or other symptoms. Per the Central Conference of American Rabbis (CCAR) guidelines, if you are unvaccinated or immunocompromised, we ask that you attend virtually.
2. Masks will be required for all attendees 2 years of age and older, regardless of vaccination status.
3. We will provide a separate seating section with social distancing for those who prefer that, and for those who are immunocompromised.
4. For those not comfortable or unable to attend in person, services will be available virtually.
5. Live music will be resuming, but will be limited to small groups singing with masks. Live music may be coupled with recorded music. Those choir members singing will be distanced from the congregation.
6. We will not have any food in the building until further notice.
7. At each service or meeting, each attendee will check in, in order to have a list of attendees for contact tracing capability. Anyone who has attended a TBY service or meeting shall notify the Temple if later tested positive for the virus. If this occurs, others who attended the service or meeting shall be notified.

All of these provisions are subject to change as needed based on the situation in the community.
