We are all so grateful for Phyllis and Maury Keiser's gift! A new TORAH for Temple Bet Yam!! This is a wonderful opportunity to celebrate! I am sure we all enjoyed writing a letter with the Sofer (The Torah Scribe) who came

to our Temple!

This month we celebrate Shavuot, Chag Matan Torah, "the time of receiving the Torah." We will celebrate the receiving of our law and our tradition on Friday, June 10th. I wonder what our Torah and our tradition could teach us about one of the most important values – Justice.

In Deuteronomy 16:18-20 it is written: "Justice, justice shall you pursue, that you may live, and inherit the land which the Lord your God gives you." Our sages discussed the repetition of the word "Justice." Why?

Some rabbis explained that the repetition is a literary device employed for emphasis. Nachmanides (1194-1270) has a different view. He understands that there are two types of Justice. The first "justice" refers to earthly courts, while the other "justice" refers to the heavenly tribunal. If man does not succeed in bringing about a just world, real judgment awaits him above. Nachmanides bases his teaching on the Sefer Bahir, one of the most obscure mystical tracts: The first justice is literal justice. This is the Divine presence. The second justice "frightens the righteous." (Bahir section 75).

This means that if a man succeeds in attaining justice, the Divine presence, the Shechina, flows. On the other hand, if man does not create a just world, Divine judgment is applied.

On another hand, it is important to remember that in Biblical times, according to Rabbenu Nissim, the king in ancient Israel had a mandate to impose sentences outside of the normal legal establishment. The reason for empowering the king in this way was to safeguard the spirit of the law from being trampled by strict adherence to the letter of the law. The mandate of the courts was to uphold the letter of the law, while the mandate of the king was to uphold the spirit of the law. Rabbenu Nissim teaches that the very person empowered to break the law must hold the Torah near and dear.

We are God's partners and we have the opportunity to apply Justice by using our courts and legal systems. I believe that real Justice comes from God. We as humans are God's partners in this world. We have the responsibility to practice Justice every day.

As we celebrate Shavuot, let us learn from our Jewish tradition and our Torah each day of our lives. Let us interpret our Torah and always promote its values to improve our legal system. Let us continue to teach our children the Book of the Books.
