ancestors wanted to elevate and honor this month.

At Temple Bet Yam we will honor Cheshvan by studying and learning. During my visits we will enjoy Friday night services, and we will study Torah on Shabbat. I hope to meet all the students at the Religious School and to learn and study with them, too.

This month is the eighth month according to the Torah. Every Jewish boy is circumcised at his eighth day to reaffirm our covenant with Abraham. May all of us this month reaffirm our covenant with TBY by learning, by praying and by gathering.

May Mar-Chesvan be a meaningful month for all of us.


