Happy Birthday, Feliz Cumpleanos, Yom Huledet Sameach are the words that we use to wish a person a new year of his/her life! This May, we will celebrate another anniversary of the State of Israel, Medinath Israel!

It is hard to imagine a world without Israel! May 14, 1948 (5 Yiar, 5708) marked a historical moment for the world of Jewry. After being persecuted, cremated, blasphemed, and killed, the State of Israel became our guarantee that we will never again be treated as second-class citizens. Today, we can choose to live in Israel or any other country, but if we need Israel, Israel will be there for us.

Since its creation, the State of Israel has contributed to improving our world. These are some of the theories and products that were discovered and developed in Israel: The model of quasicrystals, the discovery of the role of protein Ubiquitin, the Formulation of Black holes Entropy, the Pillcam endoscopic capsule developed by Given Imaging, the development of the Copaxone immunomodulator drug for treating multiple sclerosis, the Nanowire a conductive wire made of a string of tiny particles of silver, a thousand times thinner than a human hair, and the world's smallest DNA computing machine system - "the smallest biological computing device" ever constructed, according to Guinness Book of Records. Israeli devices that are more known are the USB flash drive, the quicktionary electronic dictionary – a pen-sized scanner able to scan words or phrases and immediately translate them into other languages, and the laser keyboard.

Our Jewish Reform movement has its strong presence, too. It is called Israel Movement for Progressive and Reform Judaism (IMPJ). The IMPJ seeks to strengthen Jewish identity in Israel. There are reform congregations, from Nahariya in the north to Kibbutz Lotan in the southern desert, seeking to bring Israelis closer to Jewish heritage and culture and to the values of pluralism, equality, and humanism. The oldest Reform educational presence in Israel is the Leo Baeck School in Haifa. Today in Israel, eighty percent of Israeli Jews consider themselves secular and in a recent survey, thirty-four percent of Israeli Jews said that the Progressive movement is the Jewish movement they most identify with.

This month, we celebrate Israel's seventy-four years of existence, seventy-four years of accomplishments and more to do. I dream that someday, you and I will appreciate those accomplishments with our own eyes. I dream that someday, you and I will celebrate Israel's birthday in the land of Israel!
